*Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath: EPHESIANS 4:26*



## THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF LONGSUFFERING

*But in all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses, 2 CORINTHIANS 6:4*



Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an example of suffering affliction, and of patience. JAMES 5:10

*If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? HEBREWS 12:6-7*

*But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive. GENESIS 50:20*

*Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself; is not puffed up, 1 CORINTHIANS 13:4*

*With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;*

*Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. EPHESIANS 4:1-3*

## THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF LONGSUFFERING

A. The Deliverance of \_\_\_\_\_

*The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. 2 PETER 3:9*

*Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting. 1 TIMOTHY 1:16*

B. The Deliverance of the \_\_\_\_\_

*Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.*

*Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.*

*And account [that] the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you; 2 PETER 3:13-15*
