TEN PRINCIPLES FOR WINNING YOUR CHILD'S HEART WITH DISCIPLINE:

1. IS _____ AND PREMEDITATED.

He that is slow to anger is better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city. PROVERBS 16:32

2. IS _____ PRINCIPLED AND CORRECTIVE.
