## 2. Life's growing disparity – \_\_\_\_\_

While the sun, or the light, or the moon, or the stars, be not darkened, nor the clouds return after the rain: In the day when the keepers of the house shall tremble, and the strong men shall bow themselves, and the grinders cease because they are few, and those that look out of the windows be darkened, And the doors shall be shut in the streets, when the sound of the grinding is low, and he shall rise up at the voice of the bird, and all the daughters of musick shall be brought low; Also when they shall be afraid of that which is high, and fears shall be in the way, and the almond tree shall flourish, and the grasshopper shall be a burden, and desire shall fail: because man goeth to his long home, and the mourners go about the streets: Or ever the silver cord be loosed, or the golden bowl be broken, or the pitcher be broken at the fountain, or the wheel broken at the cistern. Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it. Vanity of vanities, saith the preacher; all is vanity. ECCLESIASTES 12:2-8

**Quote:** "At this point, it doesn't appear that Solomon has aged well. He gives us a quick, metaphorical tour of what it's like to age: The arms and hands (keepers) begin to weaken and tremble. Legs, knees, and shoulders (strong men) weaken and cause one to be bent. Teeth (grinders) begin to come loose. Eyesight (windows) begins to fail. Bodily functions (doors) begin to diminish; the ears can't hear as well, the mind can't sleep as long. Heights become more fearful, falling more dangerous. Hair (almond tree) turns white and falls out. Energy (grasshopper) is decreased and movement slows. Physical desires diminish, and your desire for your "long home" in Heaven grows. Such is the unavoidable condition of aging."—**Warren Wiersbe**
