Conclusion:	

Practical Tips:

- Model a spirit of contentment before your children.
- Begin now dealing with your little ones "I want this" syndrome. Explain that we can't have everything we want, and be prepared to reinforce this lesson often!
- Teach your children to be grateful and to say "Thank you."
- Don't get caught in the game of buying your children things to keep them quiet or to relieve your guilt for not spending more time with them or failing to keep a promise.
- Don't bail your older children out if they overspend and run short for something they really want to buy or do.
